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While the cooler and more detailed 2016 is a hard act to follow, this does so with admirable aplomb despite the more typical heat of 2018. Mulled cherries, aniseed, camphor, mossy undergrowth, shiitake mushrooms and dashi. The mid-palate is savory, nourishing and slathered with umami. Aromatic and textural, with the oak and mineral notes providing tension. The finish runs very long and fresh. This is excellent. Sustainable. Drink or hold. - *Ned Goodwin MW*

Plump and plush, intense and hyper-concentrated. High cocoa solid content single estate dark chocolate, dried red cherries, cocktail cherries, kirsch, cherry brandy, pot pourri, crushed dried peony petals, lavender and assorted wild herbal notes. Tomato ketchup. Warm buttered toast. Rendered beef fat dropping onto an open oak fire. In short, there's a lot of complexity here! Colossal; monumental; deeply impressive, if not perhaps for every palate. Very intense and perhaps the most dense and compact wine in the entire September offering. - *Colin Hay*

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The 2018 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Riserva Fieramonte wafts up with a seductive blend of crushed black cherries, violet pastille, clove and a dusting of cocoa powder. This is pure elegance, mixing polished red berry fruits with crunchy mineral tones, clove and cinnamon stick, all balanced by tantalizing acidity. The 2018 shows the best qualities of the vintage: feminine and pure yet still potent, as it tapers off with amazing length and sweet tannins. I am humbled by this glorious Amarone. - *Eric Guido*

You'll know by now I just can't get enough of this wine. Coffee, liquorice, cough sweet aromas on the nose, sticky liquorice, raisins, dried strawberries. Gorgeous texture, wow, this is so drinkable. It's dialled down a notch from the excellent 2015 and 2016 vintages but the trademarks are there - grippy, salty tannins, a gorgeous sweetness on the mid palate, lots of dried fruit aromas and high acidity giving lift and length. So smooth overall with such energy to this wine yet it's deep, dense, and complex too. This is out to please and it does. Hugely satisfying and a great glass of wine. Just fantastic. The 2019 La Poja, a varietal Corvina, is darkly alluring, with nuances of tobacco and spilt pine complementing crushed black cherries. Silken and elegant, it features polished red berry fruits underscored by crisp mineral tones and a core of cooling acidity. The 2019 finishes classically dry with exceptional length, leaving a subtle bitter tinge of dark chocolate as hints of citrus add contrast. This radiant and savory La Poja will enjoy a long and glorious life in the cellar.

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An intoxicating wine for its intense aromas of spicy roses with fresh raspberries, blackberries and dark chocolate. The palate is vibrant with full body, refreshing acidity and smooth, velvety tannins with a supple, juicy finish reminiscent of toasted black pepper. It will gain complexity with bottle aging.

# Wines of the Year 2024: Italy

A cooler, wetter vintage (2019), which has imbued this Amarone with a balsamic, leafy character while retaining plenty of concentration. Rich and vibrant, it opens with mint-chocolate, coffee and black pepper scents, while a background of woody tannins supports creamy black and purple fruits. Good acidity cuts the richness, and it finishes with some red and blue berries and a leafy note.- *James Button*

The 2022 Valpolicella Classico Superiore Grola is vibrant in the glass, with a bouquet of crushed blackberries, sweet herbs and spice. It is soothingly round, pure and lifted, with crisp red berry fruits swirling beneath an air of rosy inner florals. A pleasantly bitter tinge remains, leaving the palate cleansed through the medium-length finale. This is the first vintage of Grola, a truly gastronomic Valpolicella.
