CLIMAT

Chambertin lies on outcrops of Lower Bajocian crinoidal limestone (a limestone formed with fossils) in the middle of the slope, while higher up, Bajocian marls dominate. A thin layer of scree and silt covers the entire climat, whose soils are exclusively brown limestone.

PLOT

The Domaine's parcel is located in the southern part of the appellation, just 60 meters north of the Chambertin wall. Positioned mid-slope, the Clos de Bèze estate stands out for its vitality, thanks to a youthful planting from 1972. Like Chambertin, it benefits from an ideal altitude, abundant stones, and naturally perfect drainage, while its exposure to the rising sun is unmatched.

CHARACTER

2021, a winemaker's vintage. A vintage that demanded perseverance and patience, given the climatic challenges of the season. But what pride in the result. Our Pinot Noirs stand out for their finesse and freshness. The wines of Domaine Rebourseau, delicate and elegant, embody a classicism worthy of the greatest Burgundies.
