CHARMES-CHAMBERTIN

CLIMAT

Charmes-Chambertin is situated upon a limestone outcrop thinly covered with a 25cm layer of rendzina soil. There is significant iron in this pebbly, marly soil, with iron particles appearing at the surface. This appellation is separated from the Chambertin appellation by the Route des Grands Crus and differs from the Mazoyères Chambertin situated lower down the hill which can also be labelled Charmes-Chambertin.

PLOT

The Domaine's plots are situated exclusively in Charmes Chambertin within its uppermost area. The plots have the benefit of being unified, producing wine which is a faithful representation of this climat.
