CLIMAT

Stretching south beyond Gevrey-Chambertin, Les Corvées is situated in an area that is relatively flat with rich soils. This gives a taste of the finesse of the premiers crus which border its southern extremity.

PLOT

In front of the Domaine a road leading to the house marks the boundary between Aux Corvées and la Brunelle. This boundary marks a very clear variation in character. Scree deposits are more disparate. The soil here is relatively deep, reaching depths of one metre.
