CLIMAT

La Brunelle is located at the heart of the projecting ledge which forms an excellent silt trap. This climat has been described by experts as "one of the greatest successes of the Combe de Lavaux's alluvial cone." On the surface brown soils predominate, just below are the limestone gravels that are effective in maintaining the heat. In the lower part of this climat, clustered piles of calcareous stones are to be found. A layer of sand and clay is situated two meters below the surface.

PLOT

La Brunelle is inextricably linked to the history of the house, from which this remarkable plot takes its name. Domaine Henri Rebourseau is the exclusive proprietor of this appellation whose vineyard plot extends beyond the house and grounds within a large walled enclosure.
